


Tipping Card Instructions

1. Cut card out along dotted line. *Our lawyers say you should watch your fingers while doing this.*
2. Fold in half.

Use double-sided tape to hold it together, or paste it on a business card

TRANSPORT
 Porters: \$1/bag
 Doormen: \$1/bag;
 \$1 hail taxi
 Taxi/Limo Driver: 10-15%

HOTELS
 Bellman: \$1-\$2/bag
 Concierge: \$5-10
 Maids: \$2/day
 Room Service: 15%*

GUIDED TOURS
 Tour Guide: \$1/person (half day)
 \$2/person (full day)
 Tour Manager: \$3-\$8/person/day

CRUISES
 Dining Room Waiter:
 \$3.50/person/day
 Busboy: \$2/person/day
 Room Steward: \$3.50/person/day

TIPPING ADVICE
 The amounts mentioned here should be used only as a guide. Customary tips vary from one place to another. (A 15-20% tip for wait staff is common in the USA but in the UK it is 10%.) Generally speaking, tips are seldom expected but always appreciated. Feel free to tip anyone you feel has provided excellent service!
